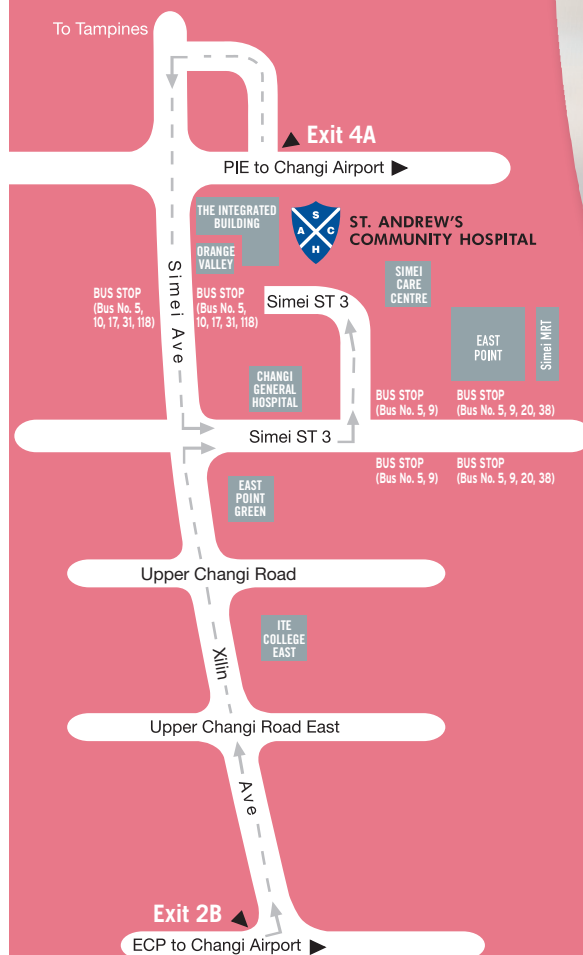

## Paediatric Care Programme

The paediatric care programme at SACH is person centred; offering customised therapy sessions (physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech and music therapy) for paediatric patients after their acute phase of treatment at an acute care hospital.

The Clinical Care Team provides care for children aged 2-18 years with the following medical conditions:

- Developmental Delay
- Neurological and Cardiopulmonary problems such as Cerebral Palsy and Congenital Heart Diseases
- Genetic Disorders such as Down Syndrome and Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy

## The Special Education Tutor

The Special Education tutor provides bi-weekly multi-sensorial sessions to help patients with special needs in their fine motor, language and cognitive development.

## The Physiotherapists

The Physiotherapists use movement and exercises as therapeutic tools for paediatric patients, with emphasis on range of motion and flexibility, bed mobility, head and trunk control, sitting and standing balance, basic functional mobility skills and respiratory care.



## The Occupational Therapists

The Occupational Therapists increase play and socialisation skills of paediatric patients. The Occupational Therapists also advise on strategies to improve behavioral management and enhance cognitive development.

## The Speech Therapists

The Speech Therapists assist in management of safe swallows by recommending diet consistency suitable for children.

## The Music Therapist

The Music Therapist supports the development of cognitive (pre-academic), behavioral, physical, emotional, communication and social skills of the paediatric patients. It engages all senses, encourages and facilitates learning, socialization, communication, emotional expression and movement.



## Admission by Referral

Admission to SACH for children requiring rehabilitative care are by referrals only. The referral may be initiated by the doctor of the acute care hospital that the patient is receiving care from.

## Means Test

A means test assessment for eligibility to government subsidy is available for all patients.
