

PRIMARY CARE PLAN FOR WORKERS

The Ministry of Manpower requires all employers of migrant workers (work permit holders and S Pass Holders) who live in dormitories or work in the Construction, Marine Shipyard and Process (CMP) sectors to purchase a Primary Care Plan (PCP) from Anchor Operators for their employees.

The PCP is designed to cover most of the migrant workers' primary care needs, and give migrant workers greater peace of mind when accessing primary healthcare.

St. Andrew's Migrant Worker Medical Centre (SAMWMC) is the Anchor Operator for Zone F.

Employers are charged \$108 per worker (rate before GST) annually for a PCP.

Workers must also pay additional fees

SCOPE OF SERVICES UNDER PCP

- Consultation and treatment for acute or chronic medical conditions
- One medical examination for work pass application or renewal
- Scheduled transportation to and from dormitories for those reporting sick
- Telemedicine including online consultation and delivery of medication
- Annual health screening

VALIDITY

PCP is valid for 1 year on an auto-renewal basis unless terminated by the employer.

WHO WE ARE

St. Andrew's Mission Hospital (SAMH) has been caring for the community through its health and community care services since 1913. Its development into one of Singapore's largest community care organisations with core services in medical, rehabilitative, palliative, dementia and elder care, has significantly benefited the sick, disadvantaged and vulnerable.

Appointed as the first of six anchor operators by the Ministry of Manpower (MOM) to provide primary care for migrant workers, SAMH partnered with the Estate of Khoo Teck Puat, the Estate of Ng Teng Fong, as well as the Singapore Business Federation Foundation (SBF Foundation), to set up St. Andrew's Migrant Worker Medical Centre (SAMWMC).

This dedicated medical centre is located within Penjuru Recreation Centre and serves 80,000 migrant workers living in the surrounding areas. Its services will bring quality medical, therapy, dental and mental health care to the migrant worker community in an environment that is healing and welcoming.

RANGE OF SERVICES



Primary Care

Treatment of acute conditions such as upper respiratory tract infections and management of chronic conditions such as diabetes mellitus and hypertension



Point-of-care Tests

Onsite tests such as electrocardiogram (ECG), urine screening and glucose checks



Medical Examination

Physical examination, blood tests and X-rays for work pass applications and renewals



Radiography

X-ray services for screening and diagnosis



Vaccination

COVID-19, Influenza and Chickenpox



Mobile Clinical Team

Medical consultation and treatment in the dormitories when necessary



Telemedicine

Consultation with a doctor through video calls

Additional services not covered under the Primary Care Plan (PCP)



Dental Care

Examination and treatment to the teeth, including dental X-rays



Therapy

Therapy exercises to improve muscle strength, flexibility and mobility as well as relieve pain



Mental Health and Case Management Services

Services that promote the mental, emotional and social well-being of workers through early intervention, peer support programmes, care coordination and counselling
