Outpatient Clinic

St. Andrew's Mission Hospital Clinic

- Located within St. Andrew's Community Hospital (Simei), St. Andrew's Mission Hospital (SAMH) Clinic provides General Practitioner Services such as non-emergency general medical consultation, medical examinations, wound dressing, health screening and vaccination services.
- It is also a Healthier SG clinic, a national initiative that allows patients enrolled with us to receive a personalised health plan and enjoy subsidised rates for chronic medication, similar to polyclinics.

Migrant Worker Medical Centre

St. Andrew's Migrant Worker Medical Centre

- Treats migrant workers' acute and chronic medical conditions.
- Provides medical examination for work pass application or renewal.
- Provides dental treatment, physiotherapy and mental well-being counselling services for migrant workers.

SENIOR SERVICES

Cluster Operators

Anglican Cluster Operator (Jurong East, PEACE-Connect)

- Look after the welfare of seniors living in the community through care coordination, case management, and other support services.
- Provide Community Case Management Services, Community, Resource, Engagement and Support Team (CREST), Befriending, Home Personal Care, Healthy Ageing Promotion Programme For You (HAPPY) and Senior Group Homes Services.

Active Ageing Centres

St. Andrew's Active Ageing Centre (Bedok North, Bedok South, Dover, Havelock, Jurong West, PEACE-Connect@5, PEACE-Connect@8, Tampines Changkat, Woodlands, Yishun)

- Provide community spaces for seniors living in the neighbourhood.
- Offer active ageing programmes as well as basic care support and befriending services to help our seniors age well in the community.

Nursing Homes

St. Andrew's Nursing Home (SANH) (Aljunied, Buangkok, Henderson, Queenstown, Taman Jurong, Tampines North) and St. John's – St. Margaret's Nursing Home (SJSN NH)

Long term nursing and rehabilitative care for residents, including persons with dementia and mental health conditions.

Senior Care Centres

St. Andrew's Senior Care (SASC) (Bedok North, Bedok South, Dover, Henderson, Hillview, JOY Connect, Queenstown, Tampines Central, Tampines North)

- Dementia Day Care, Maintenance Day Care, and Community Rehabilitation Service
- Centre-based Nursing Services: Available at SASC (Bedok South, Dover, Henderson, JOY Connect, Queenstown, Tampines Central, Tampines North)
- Community Case Management Services: The areas covered are Tampines, Changi, Hougang and Serangoon

PSYCHIATRIC SERVICES

Residential Rehabilitation

Anglican Care Centre (Hougang, Simei)

- Short to intermediate term residential rehabilitation services depending on the recovery stage of each client.
- Personalised programmes to enhance independent living skills, build confidence for community integration and improve clients' quality of life.

366 clients served in 2025

Day Rehabilitation

Anglican Care Centre

(Bukit Batok, Hougang, Pasir Ris, Simei, Yishun)

- Clients are attached to work units based on interest and ability to build up vocational and social skills under an adapted Clubhouse Model.
- Rehabilitation counsellors and programme staff work closely with clients to achieve rehabilitation goals and recovery through personalised day rehabilitation programmes.

Community Intervention Team (COMIT)

Anglican Care Centres (Bukit Batok, Pasir Ris, Yishun)

Mobile teams of professionals provide counselling, training, and support services to clients and their caregivers to sustain their recovery in the community.

1,610 clients served in 2025

Integrated Employment Services

- Offer a range of employment support services to help reintegrate clients back to the workforce.
- These include vocational training, career counselling, job placement and enhancing their personal support network.
- Provide psycho-education and consultation to companies to create greater awareness of mental health wellness.
- To equip employers with skills to support their employees in gaining mental health resilience.

Psychiatric Sheltered Home

Anglican Care Centre (Farrer Park)

- Temporary accommodation for adults recovering from mental health conditions.
- Provides counselling and case management support services to support clients' independence and facilitate community reintegration.

93 clients served in 2025

Anglican Youth Centre (Sengkang)

Pathfinders

- Provide early therapeutic interventions for the younger generation who grapple with mental health related issues in their developmental stage of life.
- Increase mental health literacy of youths and their parents.
- Empower youths to find hope and strengthen their sense of self-worth.

AUTISM SERVICES

Special Education School

St. Andrew's Autism School

- Caters to children and youths aged 7 to 18 years old.
- A comprehensive developmental curriculum that equips students with essential life skills to better prepare students for life after graduation.

324 students enrolled in 2025

Adult Autism Services

St. Andrew's Autism Centre

Provides day activity services and residential care, to enable adults with moderate to severe autism to lead dignified and meaningful lives.

► Day Activity Centres (Siglap and Sengkang)

- Provides support in the teaching of daily living skills, vocational skills, acclimatising for life in the community, as well as emotional and behavioural management skills.
- Aims to improve the independence and adaptability of adult clients to life in the community.

124 clients served in 2025



St. Andrew's Mission School

- Caters to children and youths on the autism spectrum who are able to access the national curriculum at the primary and secondary levels.
- Provides a holistic education that is founded in the mainstream academic curriculum, and enhanced by life and vocational skills training.

281 students enrolled in 2025



► Residential Services:

St. Andrew's Adult Home (Sengkang)

- Appointed by the Ministry of Social and Family Development to co-develop and operate Singapore's first Home for adults with autism.
- Designed and built to meet the needs of persons on the autism spectrum requiring specialised residential services.
- Provides residential care for adults on the autism spectrum without alternative care options in a nurturing and supportive environment.

FAMILY AND CHILDREN SERVICES

Temporary Refuge for Women and Children

Anglican Family Centre

- Safe temporary refuge for women and their children who have experienced family violence.
- Provides casework, therapeutic and support services to build up independence and resilience for community reintegration.

Children Befriending

CITY Community Services

- Reaches out to children from vulnerable families.
- Aims to develop their character and potential through befrienders clubs, camps and befrienders alumni.

- Capability building, workforce development, and digital literacy for professionals in social and healthcare sectors.
